Borrowing Seeds

- The first time you use the Little Seed Library, fill out a Membership Form.
- Choose 3 or fewer packets of seeds to take home.
- Use the Member Seed Record sheet to record which seeds you are checking out, and file that in the binder— the next time you use the library you can find your Record Sheet and add seeds you are checking out or donating.
- Take your seeds and planting instructions and enjoy!
